Urban slums house some of the poorest residents of Karachi. Most have no access to clean drinking water, sanitation or health care. Food and water-borne illness is rampant, especially affecting children. Many children are employed in trade, allowing little time for education or play.

CFC attempts to tackle many of these issues through our projects in Machar Colony, Karachi's largest unofficial *kutchi abaadi*. Your gift, however small, will go directly towards helping CFC build programs to support, empower and enrich the lives of the residents of Machar Colony.

Whether it's a month's supply of medical supplies for our Mother and Child Clinic or seeds for our Chula Chowk garden, you can trust us to spend the money wherever the need is greatest, building projects that help people overcome poverty-based obstacles to health, education and environment.

Machar Colony

Mohammadi (Machar) Colony is located behind the railroad tracks on Maripur Road in Karachi. It is a densely populated 4 sq. km. stretch of land, housing over 700,000 settlers. The colony is commonly known as Machar Colony, derived from both the large population of *machayr* i.e. fishermen in the area, as well as from the abundance of *machar* i.e. mosquitoes found in the area during the night-time. Due to legal/property issues with Karachi Port Trust (KPT), it remains one of the most underdeveloped areas of Karachi.

Although almost all residents of the community are of the Muslim religion, they come from a variety of ethnic backgrounds. The wide ethnic diversity of the community includes refugees from Afghanistan, Burma and Bangladesh.

There is an 80% illiteracy rate in the community, with a majority of these numbers being women and girls. Less than ten percent of the community's children attend school, as they are encouraged by their families to seek employment—usually within the shrimp peeling industry.



Mother Child Health Clinic (MCH)

—because all children deserve a healthy start in life

Your gift of just Rs 1000 can provide pregnancy tests leading to early diagnosis and care for 100 women

The MCH constantly provides low-cost health care services, vaccines, treatment, screenings, referrals, access to primary health, preventive health care and awareness of hygienic practices in the community. The MCH also serves as a site to administer a tuberculosis intervention program and direct observational therapy to diagnose and treat patients with tuberculosis in the community.

Strategically located within Machar Colony, the clinic houses the colony's only qualified doctor (MBBS) and services approximately 50 patients on a daily basis.

Mobile Healthcare

—because no child should miss out on life due to illness



Your gift of just Rs 25,000 can provide medical care to over 1500 school-going children for a month

Launched in 2005, CFC's Mobile Healthcare Program brings a qualified doctor into Machar Colony schools where they provide a range of free medical services to students. Medical records of each child are maintained to ensure timely follow-ups. One doctor can serve up to four schools a week, potentially treating 800 students.

Mobile healthcare means that many illnesses that would otherwise go undetected are effectively diagnosed and treated, lowering the rate of absenteeism in the school. Mobile Health Doctors also provide counseling, information and appropriate referrals as needed.

Healthcare Camps

—because every individual has the right to safe, effective, affordable treatment



Your gift of just Rs 20,000 can provide much-needed medical treatment to 50 patients

To provide health education and consultations, CFC started healthcare camps in 2000 which continue to be repeated on a quarterly basis.

Each camp provides free medical consultations, referrals for treatment, and medication, servicing approximately 400 individuals within six hours.

Traditional Birth Attendant Training

—because no woman should have to die giving life

Your gift of just Rs 5000 can ensure safe, healthy births for 10 mothers and babies

The vast majority of births in Machar Colony take place at home with little or untrained assistance. Local midwives or *daees* generally have many years of delivery experience but no instruction in identifying high risk pregnancies. In addition, a lack of access to clean delivery tools increases the risk of maternal and newborn infections.

CFC's Traditional Birth Attendant Training Program recruits local *daees* and provides comprehensive training on identifying and referring risky pregnancies as well as emphasizes clean delivery practices, family planning and infant inoculations. Because we work with midwives in the community, training also leads to a better income for them and their families.

Chula Chowk (Community Kitchen)

—because every woman has the right to feed her family well

The Chula Chowk Pilot Project is based in the Bengali area of Machar Colony, which houses people with the lowest income in the community.

The Chula Chowk houses several stoves which are equipped with LPG (gas) cylinders. Women at the kitchen cook in shifts with a one hour information session twice a week. These sessions cover nutrition, food hygiene and also serve as a platform for CFC to launch its mental health awareness talks.

A designated children's play area with a trained staff worker also provides participants' children with a safe and healthy environment for play and learning.

In addition, the art program serves an important therapeutic goal in allowing children in the community free expression and the room to work through art as a means of telling stories about their lives.

Their artwork is displayed at an annual exhibition helping to raise awareness in the general community about the deplorable conditions in which residents of Machar Colony live.

Disaster Relief

—because we can help rebuild shattered lives

CFC was heavily involved in disaster relief work in Kashmir following the devastating earthquake of 2005. Our work included care packages, mental health counseling and setting up temporary schools. As part of our commitment to the community in Kashmir, we are now building a permanent, earthquake proof school to house 100 students in Bandhi Chakka.

In addition CFC is involved in developing disaster preparedness in Machar Colony, which has no developed sewage system and floods periodically. Houses are often not waterproof and logged sewage water can enter homes, resulting in escalating rates of cholera, hepatitis and dysentery.
